Launching the STARI Program

- Register to download the STARI materials

STARI website: stari.serpmedia.org

- Introduce administrators and teachers to the STARI program

considerations: What STARI strategies will be shared with content area teachers? How will the program be budgeted for?

- Meet with leadership team to determine eligibility criteria for STARI class(es)

Resources available on the STARI website: Selecting Students for STARI

considerations: What diagnostic data will be used? Which students will benefit from STARI instruction?

- Determine assessment strategy for ongoing monitoring of student progress

considerations: What formative assessments will be used?

- Determine implementation support

considerations: Staffing STARI classrooms, coaching support, professional development

- Determine the STARI series to be used and implementation start date

considerations: Series 1 vs Series 2, staffing, curriculum organization

Managing the STARI Program

- Ensure that ALL STARI teachers have access to the materials

Resources: STARI website (stari.serpmedia.org)

- Order the STARI unit literature (This may be done all at once or throughout the year.)

Resources: STARI store (stari.serpmedia.org/store/), STARI Book List, STARI Estimated Cost Checklist

- Determine how student materials will be printed:

Option 1: Download and print the student curriculum for determined units (This may be done all at once or throughout the year.) *considerations: How much paper is needed? Who will purchase the binders? Who will manage this?*

Option 2: Order pre-printed units from SERP's print-on-demand partner, Goetz. (This may be done all at once or throughout the year.)

Sustaining the STARI Program

- Monitor student progress

considerations: Will a mid-year screening and/or end of year screening be used?

- Monitor the fidelity of implementation

considerations: What is working well? What are the challenges? What could be adjusted? What additional resources are needed?

- Collaborate with other STARI Teachers

considerations: Will STARI implementation and continuous improvement cycles be discussed throughout the year?
